The City of Pasco Information Technology Department aims to provide outstanding customer service to City staff and the greater Pasco community. As the demand for technology evolves, the IT Department extends beyond the traditional operational model with its focus on innovation, transparency, and collaboration. The IT department is a centralized full service department; the department houses the Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) technology used in our water plants, as well as Geographic Information Systems (GIS) technology.

Information Technology services provide comprehensive support in using technology, optimizing business processes, and ensuring the security and reliability of IT systems. The IT Department:

- Develops and innovates the City's business systems.
- Provides technical assistance to users who encounter issues with their computer system, software applications, or other technology-related problems.
- Designs, implements, and secures computer networks.
- Develops, customizes, maintains, and trains on software applications to meet specific business requirements.
- Provides Geographic Information System (GIS) services, such as Parcel, Utility, and Zoning Maps.

The IT Department team is a group of fun and professional individuals working together to keep the City's technology as strong as possible. The team takes a modern approach in using technology to solve problems to help the City thrive, such as implementing tools like AI to stay up-to-date on modern trends in local government. The Role

As the IT Director, they will be responsible for implementing new software that aligns with the City's desire for growth and accessibility. They will also be accountable for creating straightforward procedures and policies for internal use of new and existing technology systems.

In this role, you will oversee a team of skilled individuals, helping to delegate tasks and work together. You will have the opportunity to own this role and be free to create and implement new and exciting technologies in the City of Pasco.

The new IT Director will:

- Participate as a key member of the leadership team.
- Oversee the IT department's operations, including overseeing networks, servers, telecommunications, and security systems.
- Lead long-term technology planning and innovation in alignment with the city's growth.
- Develop and oversee the department budget.
- Build and lead a high-performing team.
- Assess and mitigate risks related to IT projects and operations.
- Ensure compliance with data protection, privacy, and cybersecurity regulations.
- Cultivate a culture of exceptional customer service within the IT department.
- Help shape organizational effectiveness.

Qualification Requirements

Experience: Seven years of progressively responsible experience in information systems experience, including significant management experience. Experience in a government setting is preferred.

Advanced knowledge of IT infrastructure, cybersecurity, cloud computing, data management, and project management methodologies.

Education: Bachelor's degree in information technology, computer science, public administration, business administration or related field; masters preferred.

Certification:

- Possession of a valid Washington driver's license upon appointment.
- PMP certification preferred.



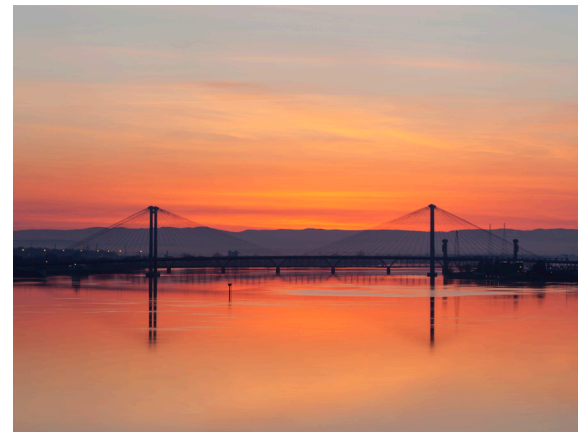

Compensation & Benefits

The annual salary range is \$150,000 - \$191,688.00

Salary survey is planned in approximately 6 months.

- **Medical Insurance:** Employee and all eligible dependents covered for \$153.70/month. Low deductible, \$200 for individual, \$600 for family.
 - **Dental Insurance:** Employee and all eligible dependents covered for \$11.59/month.
 - **Vision Insurance:** Employee and all eligible dependents covered for \$6.54/month.
 - **Life Insurance:** \$100,000 basic life insurance provided by the City.
 - **PERS Retirement Plan:** The City of Pasco participates in the Department of Retirement Systems that provides two plan options for employees:
 - **PERS II:** Employee contribution rate: 6.36%.
Employer contribution rate: 10.39%
 - **PERS III:** Employee contribution rate: employee choice.
Employer contribution rate: 10.39%

- **Mission Square Deferred Compensation Plan:** Automatic employer pre-tax contribution of 3%. Employee contribution options include pre-tax and Roth.
 - **Holidays:** The City observes 11 per year (10 scheduled, 1 "floating").
 - **Vacation Leave:** 24 days per year. Vacation leave is available for use as it is accrued.
 - **Sick Leave:** 12 days per year. Sick leave is available for use as it is accrued.
 - **Other benefits include:** Auto allowance, gym membership, comprehensive employee assistance program, short-term and long-term disability insurance, and 2% HRA VEBA salary deferral.
